Our Drinking Was But a Symptom

We are told in Alcoholics Anonymous that drinking is but a symptom of deeper-lying problems.

After voluntarily admitting myself to treatment twice, and finally being sent by the law, I finally realized over a period of about ten years that alcohol was no my problem. Alcohol was my "solution."

Each time I got ready to do a Fourth Step, I would back off. I couldn't or wouldn't admit that I was a human being and subject to all sorts of character defects. Finally, however, I did take the Fourth Step and realized that my problems were resentment, anger, jealousy, self-pity, and remorse. When one or more of these bothered me, my solution, although temporary, was to drink.

Alcohol was my drug of choice. But from talking to dually-addicted friends, I have discovered that the deeper-lying problems are the same.

Should we let the people addicted to drugs other than alcohol into closed AA meetings? I think so. We also need to offer hope that there is a solution through Narcotics Anonymous – or whatever program applies. We need to give the strength from our own experience and relate, if we can, to their feelings.

For this I am responsible, and also thankful that I can help.


