One Member's Story

"My name is Regina M. Palacios and I'm 46 years old. I am a cashier/cook at the ALANO Club of San Jose. I'm the mother of two adult children, and am currently a member of the ALANO Club Board of Directors. Badge # 57 is my number and I have been a club member since Nov. 12, 2003. I try to be very active here at the club."

"I found the program in 1998, when I was court-ordered to go to meetings by the Drug Treatment Court. To comply with the wishes of the court, I was required to get a sponsor, work the steps, and get into service. Immediately, my life began to change. I am very grateful to Judge Manley and Judge Terri at Treatment Court."

"Being court-ordered to do meetings, and I had to show proof. I was also required to do community service. The ALANO Club provided an opportunity for me to do both. Plus, the club was nearby where I lived. Over the years I had heard great things about the club...that I would get my life back, etc. Being a young woman, I knew my life had to change. God bless this wonderful place. Like many others, this place began to feel like a home."

"My life now, 12 years later, has been great. My milestone date for me being both clean and sober is March 28, 2003. I feel good. I've always known in my heart that I am a sweet person. Now, I can look into a mirror and say, 'Regina, you're Awesome!'

My children mean the world to me. My family is so supportive of the program. My oldest brother, Douglas is also in the program...so I know this works."

What Advice Do You Have for the Newcomers?

Go to lots of meetings. Get phone numbers. Listen to the Old Timers. Get a sponsor/Be a sponsor. Find a home group. Keep coming back.


