## Straight Talk From a Member of AA - Curtis S.

Who Are You? He is the official barbeque chef for the Alano Club of San Jose. You may have seen him at the club's Memorial Day Barbeque. His name is Curtis.

Curtis describes himself as "I'm a very outgoing, socializing, people-friendly person. I enjoy basketball, pinochle, football, dancing and fishing. I love to cook and I especially love to barbeque. I'm a religious person, and I love playing music. I am thoroughly committed to the program of A.A."

"I grew up in an abusive home. My Father was an alcoholic and was very abusive to my sisters and myself. My Mom had a nervous breakdown around the age of 25 or 26. Because of the abuse, I was very close to my Mom and her family. Mom left Dad when I was about age nine or 10. The guy she remarried was named Lee, who turned-out to be more of a father to me than my real Father. Lee's whole family accepted me."

**Tell me about your first drink**. "I was 11 years old and was in the 7<sup>th</sup> grade. The alcohol was Boone's Farm Strawberry Hill. I just wanted something to do."

**Tell me about your last drink?** It was November of 1987. I smoked-up and drank-up my check. So I called my Mother to get me some Help. I was 31 and 10 months of age. She took me to the Veterans Center at Valley Medical. I didn't get sober until Feb. 23<sup>rd</sup> of 1988, the day after my 32<sup>nd</sup> birthday. I've remained sober ever since 02-23-88. That's 28 years I've been sober."

**Tell me about your life now:** "My life has been more enjoyable and productive. I care about other people a lot more, Spiritually it's more rewarding. I'm able to handle situations easier and my life is more manageable and more fulfilling."

What is your advice for the Newcomer? "Find a sponsor. Work the Steps, Go to a lot of meetings. Get a Big Book. Begin doing some sort of Service Commitment."
