Remembering our Friend, Hank Coca

At the time of his death, on April 29^{th,} Mr. Coca had 37 years of Sobriety. His Sobriety birthdate is either October 24th or October 26th, 1978. (Friends are uncertain). Henry (Hank) Delgado Coca was born on July 26, 1931 and was age 85 when he peacefully died in his sleep at his home in the presence of his wife and family

Frank was survived by his wife Salome ("May"), his daughter, Renee, his son, Henry; one sister, one grandchild, plus nephews and nieces. "May" and Hank had been married for 64 years. Born in San Jose in the early 1930's. Hank began his Sales Career in his late teens going door to door selling pots and pans. Later he sold insurance policies and still in his early twenties he became a furniture sales person. At the age of 26 he opened Furniture Discount House in downtown San Jose. In recent years, his furniture store became known as Hank Coca's Downtown Furniture, and is located at Third Street and Santa Clara in downtown San Jose. *
