Why I Support the Alano Club - Happy Andy

Who Are You?

"My name is Happy Andy, and I am a Happy Alcoholic and a recovering drug addict.

When Did You Have Your First Drink?

"I had my first drink, around 1964. My addictions started first with a cigarette, then Booze. That was followed by Weed and Pills. And, last but not least was Heroin.

When Did You Have Your Last Drink?

"I had my last drink and last drug dosage on May 13, 2005. I went to 7 – 11, to get a pack of Cigarettes. I just got done doing a shot of Black Tar Heroin, had smoked a Joint, and was holding an open container. I was 'on the Nod', I don't even know how long I was there. I came out of the Nod, and noticed that a Cop was there. The Cop told me to Blow [air] into his hand. Next, he said, 'You've been drinking!' When I said 'yes' he told me to Catch a Cab home. Then the Cop let me go. I took this as a sign – and the next day I went back to A.A.

How Did You Find Out About the A.A. Twelve-Step Program?

"My aunt suggested I go to A.A. That was back in 1987 and my first meeting was in San Leandro. The topic was 'resentments', and I had them in spades. I broke-down and cried. I had struggled with various addictions since 1987. My first Arrest was in 1969. My first program was 1971 and my last program was in 2002. Thankfully, my last arrest was in 2002.

How did you find out about the ALANO Club of San Jose?

"A friend of mine – in recovery – introduced me to the ALANO Club. We both lived in Fremont. In 2005, I was coming to the ALANO Club every day. The place saved my life. I knew if I stayed home, I would lose to my addiction. Staying home just encouraged the addictive voices shouting in the 'battlefield of my mind.' I definitely believe in the Club and what it represents. It has helped me tremendously!

What Is Your Life Like Now?

"I'm Happy, and I don't have any problems. I'm living a dream. I learned not to feel sorry for myself, 'no matter what', is going on in my life or in the world, If I think I have a problem, most likely, I'm the Problem. I strive to practice all the Steps and the Principles 'in all my affairs.'

What Is Your Advice for the Newcomer

"The thing that really saved me, was to study the Big Book. The Newcomer needs to study the Steps so they can work them properly. 'When you are Ready, You will Change!'"
