Why I Am a Member - By Freddie Parra

Tell Us, "Who Are You?"

"My name is Freddie Parra. I am from San Jose, and have been Clean since August 17, 2003. I am a Father of five girls and the grandfather of four."

Freddie, at what age were you when you had your first drink or used your first Addictive Substance? Please tell us about that situation, and how your mind convinced you to give it a try:

"I was 10 years old when I had my first drinks. It was at my parents 25th wedding anniversary and everyone was drinking and someone passed a Margarita and I drank it. That was the first time I got buzzed."

When Did You Have Your Last Drink, or Your Last Drug?

"I don't really remember my last drink because I was so into my 'drug of choice', which was Meth. But, it was around the same time as when I got Clean, which was on August 17th, 2003."

How did you find out about AA or your own Twelve Step Program?

"Through the County."

When did you first find out about the ALANO Club of San Jose?

"I have lived in the neighborhood to our club my whole life. So I knew about this place.

As we grow in our Recovery, the Quality of Life improves, and our former 'Scary Life' stops being such a Challenge – and as we work our program – our new way of Life now becomes 'A Life of Peace, Love, Joy and Satisfaction.' How long into the Program before you discovered a 'New Way of Life' and that the Ninth Step 'Promises' were now manifesting into your Life?

About six months into the program I was still on Parole and Probation. I was a Prop 36 client and was taking some helpful classes. We were at the end of the program and the facilitator told me that if all my fees were not paid, she would send a negative report to my probation officer. I was pretty upset, I had the money, but I didn't want to pay,

Well, I decided to pay her and it was the first time in my adult life that I made a decision that kept me out of jail. I have heard that this was real, and that the *'promises'* were coming to fruition in my life."

Freddie, What Is Your Advice for the Newcomer?

"Never give up and put your best foot forward."
